WE'RE TESTING TOGETHER **BERNINA | ENGIADINA BASSA/VAL MÜSTAIR | MALOJA**

Working together against the coronavirus is the only way to beat the pandemic quickly and effectively. Over the test weekend in the regions of Bernina, Engiadina Bassa/Val Müstair and Maloja, everyone will be able to get a free test.

Where will the tests take place?

Tests will be carried out in the regions of Bernina, Engiadina Bassa/Val Müstair and Maloja. There will be a total of 23 test locations, more details can be found at www.gr.ch/corona-test or on your municipality's website.

When can I get a test?

December 11–13th, 2020 (Friday to Sunday),
8.00–18.00 hrs.

What will the test cost?

The test is free.

Who can get a test?

Everyone! Visitors and residents from other municipalities are also invited to get a free test. Participants must be over 10 years old. Minors must be accompanied by a parent.

Do I need to register?

Yes. To ensure that the process runs as smoothly as possible and to avoid long waiting times, registration is required. You can select your preferred time at www.gr.ch/corona-test.

Can I get help with the registration?

You can also register other people, such as family members. If you don't have anyone who can help you with the registration, you can call the hotline on 081 254 16 00.

Is the test compulsory?

No, participation is voluntary. However, every test helps to contain the virus.

Who carries out the tests?

Tests are carried out by medical professionals. Distancing and hygiene regulations will be strictly observed.

What kind of test will be carried out?

The test is a rapid antigen test. The sample is taken using a nasal and throat swab.

What do I need to bring to the test?

You need to bring a valid ID card / pass and the code (QR code) that you receive with your registration confirmation. This can be shown on your phone or printed out.

How long does the test take?

The whole process at the test location takes around 15 minutes. Registration helps to make the process smooth and simple. You don't need to wait at the test location for the test result. After around 30 minutes, you will receive a text with your test result.

What do I do if it's positive?

If this happens, you will still receive the result in a text. We will also send you information about what self-isolation means and what measures you need to take.

What do I do if it's negative?

The rapid test is a snapshot. If you later develop symptoms, contact your doctor. It is vital that you comply with the measures stated by the Federal Office of Public Health: Wear a mask, keep your distance and wash your hands.
