Domestic violence involves the use or threat of violence within the family, or against a current or former partner.

Violence has many forms, such as for instance:

Physical violence: hitting, shoving, shaking, biting or grabbing

Psychological violence: insulting, threatening, offending or causing anxiety

Sexual violence: forcing a person to be involved in a sexual act and all sexual acts by adults

and adolescents on or in front of children.

Economic violence: taking away money or forbidding someone from working

Social violence: confining a person or preventing them from meeting family or friends

Domestic violence is not tolerated and is a criminal offence.
